TAMARIKI RISE CHILDREN'S FAMILY VIOLENCE EDUCATION







Every child deserves a life free from violence. Getting the right support now is so important to their future.

Family violence hurts everyone in the family, especially children.
Experiencing, or even just seeing or hearing violence, can severely damage a child's emotional and psychological wellbeing.

Aviva offers Tamariki Relationship and Individual Safety Education (RISE) to help children who have experienced or witnessed violence move toward a safe and healthy violence-free future.

"The whole thing was so good for Madeline". She'd gone from being a confident kid to being so anxious and frightened to take risks. I saw her carrying herself differently. But going through the education programme and learning her safety plan made such a difference. She's got so much of her confidence back.

-Rachel* Mother of Tamariki RISE Participant Tamariki RISE offers support to children aged 5–12. The course is delivered in a fun, child-centred way, and is designed to be a positive experience for each child.

Children will:

- Develop their own plans to stay safe
- Learn about healthy relationships
- Be supported to build their selfconfidence
- Have positive, trusting experiences with others
- Find appropriate ways to deal with their anger
- Learn what to do when they recognise abuse
- enjoy snacks, games and fun



When is Tamariki RISE held?

The 10-week groups are run during school terms. The programme can also be delivered individually by a professionally qualified Family Support Worker.

Where is Tamariki RISE held?

It is run in locations across Christchurch, mid-Canterbury, Selwyn and North Canterbury.

How can my child get to the programme?

Assistance with transport may be available. Aviva can offer pick-up and return from the child's school.

How do I sign my child up for Tamariki RISE?

If you are already engaged with a family support worker at Aviva or another organisation, please express your interest with them.

The youth equivalent, Rangatahi RISE is also available individually for young people aged 13-18.
